

Coordinated Services Team Eligibility

A child having needs in two of the following areas may qualify for a Coordinated Service Team

- Behavioral Health (Mental/AODA)
- Academically Challenged
- Medically Fragile or Physical Disability
- Child Welfare Services (Prevention, ICW, Child Protection, Juvenile Justice)
- Other Interventions have not been successful over time
- At risk for Out of Home Placement
- And most importantly, the parents are willing to be involved in the Coordinated Services Team process


