## DISABILITIES PROGRAM AT-A-GLANCE

**VISION:** The Disabilities Department envisions a program that ensures all Ho-Chunk children and students with disabilities are provided a meaningful education which is equal, accessible, and culturally appropriate.

---

**MISSION:** The mission of the Disabilities Program is to provide disability advocacy services to Ho-chunk children and adult students with disabilities so they may access the general education curriculum and benefit from specialized instruction, related services, academic adjustments, or accommodations under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA), Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

**WHO WE ARE:** The Disabilities Program was established through the passage of the Ho-Chunk Nation's Disability Code with the intent to provide disability services to children and adult students who are disabled and enrolled in school.

---

**WHAT WE DO:** The Disabilities Program provides disability advocacy services through direct case management, disability training, information and referral, and technical assistance given to parents of minor children with disabilities, adult students in higher education, and to Ho-Chunk Nation staff working with Ho-Chunk families.

The Disabilities Program, Health and Social Services are working together to provide necessary services for people with disabilities.
