GRANT FOR AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA  
NATIVE TRIBES AND TRIBAL ORGANIZATIONS  
RESOLUTION 8-06-08 A**

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a New Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") grants the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** the mission of the Health and Social Services Department is to provide a high level of health care essential to the improvement of the quality of life within the Ho-Chunk Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Services has announced competitive grant applications for Tribal Management Grants to support the health management structure serving the Tribe/Tribal organization; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Management Grant Program has identified measurable outcomes related to health management structure in the amount of \$100,000 per year for up to three years; and
- WHEREAS,** the Division of Health has identified a need to provide software support, training, and technical support that will enhance the health care services to tribal members; and
- WHEREAS,** one of the Division of Health's priorities is to access alternative funding sources for priority health needs.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature endorses its support for the Division of Health to pursue a three-year Tribal Management Grant Program for American Indian and Alaska Native Tribes and Tribal Organizations grant application.

### CERTIFICATION
