BETWEEN THE HO-CHUNK NATION DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING
HOME OWNERSHIP PROGRAM
AND BLACK RIVER FALLS SCHOOL DISTRICT
NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION PROJECT
RESOLUTION 10-5-10 K**

- WHEREAS**, on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and
- WHEREAS**, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") grants the Ho-chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2(b) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to establish Executive Department, and to delegate legislative powers to the Executive branch to be administered by such Departments, in accordance with the law; any Department established by the Legislature shall be administered by the Executive; the Legislature reserves the power to review any action taken by virtue of such delegated power; and
- WHEREAS**, under the Ho-Chunk Nation Code Title 8-Housing, Real Estate, and Property Code Section 5-Home Ownership and Benefit Housing Program for the General Welfare of Non-Elders Act, also known as the Home Ownership Program (HOP) to be administered by the Department of Housing; and
- WHEREAS**, the Ho-Chunk Nation Homeownership Program administered by the Ho-Chunk Nation Department of Housing in agreement with the Black River Falls School District through the Construction II Class, will construct a new Homeownership Program home; and
- WHEREAS**, the new home located at W11303 Krome Road, Black River Falls, WI will be afforded to an enrolled member of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved in accordance with the guidelines set forth within the Ho-Chunk Nation Code Title 8-Housing, Real Estate, and Property Code Section 5-Home Ownership and Benefit Housing Program for the General Welfare of Non-Elders Act.
