### HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE APPOINTED STATUS FOR THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT JOB DESCRIPTIONS/POSITIONS RESOLUTION 11-3-10 F

**WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

**WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

**WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (f) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to set salaries, terms, and conditions of employment for all government personnel; and

**WHEREAS,** the President of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("President") shall appoint all individuals to serve in his/her administration as employees of the Office of the President; and

**WHEREAS,** Article VI, Section 2(a) states that "the President shall have the power to select and hire personnel in accordance with applicable law;" and

**WHEREAS,** as a policy matter of fundamental fairness, the President deems that there is a need for all current and future job descriptions utilized by the Office of the President to be designated as appointed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature, pursuant to its Constitutional authority, hereby designates that all current and future job descriptions utilized by the Office of the President are hereby considered appointed.

#### CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Tribal Secretary for the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature, hereby certify that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation, composed of **13 members**, of whom **9** constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly called and convened on the **3rd day of November, 2010**, and that the foregoing resolution was adopted by an affirmative vote of **6 members, 1 opposed, and 2 abstaining**, pursuant to the authority of Article V, Section 2(a) through (x) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 1, 1994, and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way. I further certify that this is a verified copy of said resolution.
