### HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE IN SUPPORT OF HEAD START GRANT APPLICATION

#### RESOLUTION 12-20-11 A

**WHEREAS,** On November 1, 1994 the Secretary of the Interior approved a new constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formally known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation, and

**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, and

**WHEREAS,** Article V Section 2 (a) enables the Nation, through the Legislature, to make laws, including codes, ordinances resolutions and statutes; and


**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation's Head Start program's purpose is to provide our Nation's pre-school children with an early, safe and effective preparation for the beginning of their school years. In addition, we believe Ho-Chunk pre-school children will receive the care, advocacy, and assistance with their preparation goals only from a fully funded Head Start Program; and


**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Head Start Program has taken an aggressive position to promote the goals and objectives cited in the Head Start Federal Grant application which plans, implements and evaluates the specific funding needs of the Head Start Program:

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Legislature supports the Head Start Program as it applies for a grant of federal funds to implement its goals and objectives for FY 2012-2013 in the amount of \$881,342.

#### CERTIFICATION
