RESOLUTION 06-21-11 A**

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation (Nation) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Nation, and has been given certain powers pursuant to the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution (Constitution) grants the Legislature, to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2 (i) of the Constitution grant the Legislature the power to negotiate and enter into treaties, contracts, and agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2 (s) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to promote public health, education, charity, and such other services as may contribute to the social advancement of the members of Ho-Chunk Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk nation Division of Social Services-Community supportive Services is applying for a grant for two Aging Disabilities Resources Specialist workers. One based in Black River Falls and the other one in the Wittenberg area

WHEREAS, the services will be designed to work with Ho-Chunk Tribal members seeking assistance with applications for disabilities, finding a facility for tribal elders if needed. To be an advocate for the Tribal member

WHEREAS, the grant is for \$94,420.00 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature renders its full support for the 2011-2012 ADRS grant submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Health Services to assist tribal members needing assistance with disabilities and the aging population.
