HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE INVENTORY UPDATE LIST RESOLUTION 03-09-11 C

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation, and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Legislature") is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Constitution"); and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes, and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2, (i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreement with other governments, organizations, or individual; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation recognizes adequate and safe road infrastructure is critical to all Tribal development; and
- WEHREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs shares responsibility for developing and maintaining roads on Indian lands; and
- WEHREAS,** the Ho-Chunk wishes to update its road inventory to address the critical need for expanded and improved road infrastructure for a rapidly developing Tribal community.


NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Legislature, hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to add, update, or delete the roads listed in the attachment to the Ho-Chunk Nation Indian Reservation Road Inventory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following names of roads and the assignment of the BIA route numbering system are attached to this resolution as Attachment A and are to be included in the update of the Long Range Transportation Plan on the attached forms.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Nation hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to update and add the lists of roads in the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road Inventory.
