HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE RESOLUTION 05-17-11 B

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation, and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Legislature") is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Constitution"); and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes, and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2, (i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreement with other governments, organizations, or individual; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation recognizes adequate and safe road infrastructure is critical to all Tribal development; and

WEHREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs shares responsibility for developing and maintaining roads on Indian lands; and

WEHREAS, the Ho-Chunk wishes to update its Long Range Transportation Plan to reflect changing conditions and priorities of the Nation and address the critical need for expanded and improved road infrastructure for a rapidly developing Tribal community.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Legislature, hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to update the Ho-Chunk Nation Roads Divisions Long Range Transportation Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Long Range Transportation Plan is attached to this resolution as Attachment A and is to be included in the annual inventory update.
