HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE PASSAGE OF AMENDS TO THE APPROPRIATIONS AND BUDGET PROCESS ACT (2 HCC §4)

RESOLUTION 05-03-11 D

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") gives the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(b) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to establish Executive Departments, and to delegate legislative powers to the Executive branch to be administered by such Departments, in accordance with the law; any Department established by the Legislature shall be administered by the Executive; the Legislature reserves the power to review any action taken by virtue of such delegated power; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(d) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to authorize expenditures by law and appropriate funds to the various Departments in an annual budget; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(x) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to enact any other laws, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes necessary to exercise its legislative powers delegated by the General Council pursuant to Article III including but not limited to the foregoing list of powers; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature adopted the Appropriations and Budget Process Act ("Budget Act") in the year 2000 as a way for the various Branches of the Ho-Chunk Nation Government to have guidance in preparing budgets and ensure fiscal responsibility and integrity within the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Nation's Budget Act contains provisions detailing the manner in which the Legislature shall carry out its Constitutional function to appropriate funds for the Nation, while also noting deadlines for the Executive, Judicial and Legislative Branches to submit annual budgets; and

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WHEREAS, the Budget Act does not address the General Council Branch of Government or provide any guidance for the appropriation of funds to said Branch; and

WHEREAS, due to the Budget Act's silence as to the General Council Branch of Government, the Legislature deems it necessary to amend the Budget Act to include provisions addressing the budgets and appropriations for the General Council Branch; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation General Council Agency noted this issue to the Legislative Finance Committee on October 28, 2010 at a Special Finance Meeting and, in response, the Committee made a motion to amend the Budget Act to include the General Council; and

WHEREAS, the General Council Agency's counsel has provided comments as to the various parts of the Budget Act that need amendment, and has worked with Legislative Counsel to confirm the appropriate amendments; and

WHEREAS, the language amending the Budget Act is contained in the attached excerpts of the Budget Act; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature adopted the Legislative Organization Act (2 HCC § 11) to govern the manner in which the Legislature adopts or amends the laws of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, Section 31, subparagraph d(1)(a) of the Legislative Organization Act provides that the Public Review period for consideration of proposed laws or amendments will typically be forty-five (45) days; and


WHEREAS, The Legislature adopted Resolution 12-7-10 R to place the proposed amendments to the Appropriations and Budget Process Act out for forty-five day public comment; and

WHEREAS, The Legislative Office did not receive any comments during the forty-five days it was posted; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature amends the Budget Act to include the General Council, pursuant to its Constitutional Authority.
