### **HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE LEGISLATIVE RECOGNITION CITATION IN RECOGNITION OF ALVIN CLOUD**

#### **RESOLUTION 2-22-11 G**

**WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

**WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") gives the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

**WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(x) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to enact any other laws, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes necessary to exercise its legislative powers delegated by the General Council pursuant to Article III including but not limited to the foregoing list of powers; and

**WHEREAS,** the Legislature is authorized under Section 27 of the Nation's Legislative Organization Act to issue a Legislative Recognition Citation to a particular person, or for an occasion, and to give recognition to certain persons or events deserving of such high honor; and

**WHEREAS,** Alvin Cloud, an honored and distinguished member of the Ho-Chunk Nation, recently passed, and the Legislature wishes to adopt a Legislative Recognition Citation to honor Alvin and his family; and

**WHEREAS,** the Legislature wishes to formally recognize Alvin and his many achievements in life and his importance to the Ho-Chunk Nation People and tribal government; and

**WHEREAS,** the Legislature has not previously issued a Recognition Citation, but finds it fully appropriate on this occasion, to honor Alvin Cloud;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Legislature, pursuant to its Constitutional authority, and under the Legislative Organization Act, hereby authorizes the creation and adoption of a Legislative Recognition Citation to honor Alvin Cloud and his family; and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Legislature requests the assistance of the Executive Branch to collaborate in preparing the Citation and authorizes the President and Vice President, and all Legislators, to execute said Citation; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Legislature, by this enactment, authorizes the President and Vice President to sign this Resolution, along with the Tribal Secretary.

**CERTIFICATION**

I, the undersigned, as Tribal Secretary of Ho-Chunk Nation, hereby certifies that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation, composed of **13 members** of whom **7** constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly called and convened and held that on the **22<sup>nd</sup> day of February, 2011**, that the foregoing resolution was adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of **7 members, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining**, pursuant to the Article V, Section 2(a) and (x) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 1, 1994, and that the foregoing resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
