HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN RESOLUTION 4-20-10 A


- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe, and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") grants the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes, and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2, (i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreement with other governments, organizations, or individual; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation recognizes adequate and safe road infrastructure is critical to all Tribal development; and
- WEHREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs shares responsibility for developing and maintaining roads on Indian lands; and
- WEHREAS,** the Ho-Chunk wishes to update its Transportation Improvement Plan to address the critical need for expanded and improved road infrastructure for a rapidly developing Tribal community.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Legislature, hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to update the roads listed in the attachment to the Ho-Chunk Transportation Improvement Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following names of roads/properties are attached to this resolution as Attachment A and are to be included in the update of the Transportation Improvement Plan.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Tribal Secretary for the Ho-Chunk Nation, hereby certify that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation, composed of the 13 members, of whom 11 constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting duly called and convened and held on the 20th day of April, 2010, that the foregoing resolution was adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 11 members, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining, pursuant to the authority of Article V, Section 2 (a) and (x) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 1, 1994, and that the foregoing resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
