HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE
APPROVAL OF SALVAGE TIMBER SALE ON CLARK COUNTY FEE PARCELS:
PLUM CREEK 40 AND MYRLE THOMPSON IN THE TOWNS OF DEWHURST & LEVIS
RESOLUTION 8-03-10B

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") empowers the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislatures") to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (i) of the Constitution grants the Legislature to power to negotiate Agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (l) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to enact laws to manage, lease, permit, or otherwise deal with the Nation's lands, interests in lands or other assets; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Division of Natural Resources is responsible for managing air, land, and water resources; monitoring and controlling toxins, wastes, and pollutants; and protecting wildlife, fish, and plant resources from overuse and abuse; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature agrees upon a salvage timber harvest on pt. of SW1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30 T23N-R2W (11.2 acres) and pt. of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 T23N-R3W (approx.12.2 acres) in Clark County, Wisconsin
- WHEREAS,** the Constitution reserves to the Legislature, the power of oversight, but daily operations and management is the responsibility of the Executive Branch, so long as the actions of the Executive Departments are not contrary to the laws created by the Legislature.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature hereby authorizes & approves the above referenced timber sale on pt. of SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30 T23N-R2W in the town of Levis, Clark County, Wisconsin; and pt. of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 T23N-R3W in the town of Dewhurst, Clark County, Wisconsin, pursuant to the authority delegated by the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution.
