

FOR THE HO-CHUNK NATION  
RESOLUTION 08-17-10 B**

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Legislature") is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Nation ("Constitution"); and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) enables the Nation, through the Legislature, to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Division of Natural Resources is responsible for managing air, land, and water resources; monitoring and controlling toxins, wastes, and pollutants; and protecting wildlife, fish, and plant resources from overuse and abuse; and
- WHEREAS,** the Nation recognizes the need to establish a comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan and Native Species Restoration Plan in order to protect tribally significant wildlife resources.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature hereby support the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Tribal Wildlife Grant application for the Establishment of a comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan and Native Species Restoration Plan guided by elk restoration efforts.

### HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE APPROPRIATION FOR LABOR DAY POW-WOW 2010 RESOLUTION 8-17-10 C

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution, Article V, Section 2 (a) empowers the Legislature to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** the HCN Constitution, Article V, Section 2 (d) empowers the Legislature to authorize expenditures from available funds for public purposes; and
- WHEREAS,** the HCN Legislature approved a pow-wow budget at a duly convened Legislative session on August 17, 2010; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature hereby authorizes that an appropriation of the attached budget be provided on an expedited basis to the appointed individuals Barbara Funmaker & Lance Blackdeer, of the joint pow-wow committee, as approved by the Legislature; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the joint pow-wow committee shall reconcile the pow-wow budget within thirty (30) days after the last day of the pow-wow.
