
**HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE
AUTHORIZING PROVISION OF LIMITED ENROLLMENT
INFORMATION TO WISCONSIN BUREAU OF CHILD SUPPORT
RESOLUTION 2-09-10 D**

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") grants the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(i) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and
- WHEREAS,** the Nation wishes to provide limited enrollment information ("Confidential Information") to the State of Wisconsin, Bureau of Child Support ("BCS") and the State of Wisconsin, Bureau of Information Technology ("BIT") for the sole purpose of expunging birthing and lying-in expenses from its child support files; and
- WHEREAS,** the Nation's Department of Heritage Preservation, Office of Tribal Enrollment maintains such Confidential Information; and
- WHEREAS,** the scope and use of the Confidential Information will be defined by a Confidential Disclosure Agreement ("Agreement"), which would be signed by all parties (a copy of the draft Agreement is attached);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature authorizes either the President or Vice President to sign the Agreement, on behalf of the Nation, to allow BCS and BIT to receive and use Confidential Information for the sole purpose of expunging birthing and lying-in expenses from the child support files of Ho-Chunk Nation tribal members.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Tribal Secretary for the Ho-Chunk Nation, hereby certify that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation, composed of 13 members, of whom 7 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly called and convened and held on the 9th day of February, 2010, that the foregoing resolution was adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 7 members, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining, pursuant to the authority of Article V, Section 2(a) and (x) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 1, 1994, and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way. I further certify that this is a verified copy of said resolution.
