### HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE SUPPORT OF JOHNSON O'MALLEY RESOLUTION 05-18-10 B

**WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation; and

**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

**WHEREAS,** the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Nation, and has been given certain powers pursuant to the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation; and

**WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) enables the Nation, through the Legislature, to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and


**WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation has contracted with the Bureau of Indian Affairs a Consolidated Tribal Grants Program for Education, Human Services, Public Safety, and Justice Programs in the past and wishes to continue, and


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Nation negotiate and contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs a Consolidated Tribal Grants Program contract for fiscal year 2010 starting October 1, 2009 and for any additional funds made available during the current fiscal year for the operation of the Johnson O'Malley program, and

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Nation negotiate and contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs a Consolidated Tribal Grants Program contract for the remainder of the contract term, fiscal years 2011 and 2012, and for any additional funds beyond the initial contract amount made available during the remainder of the contract term for the operation of the Johnson O'Malley program

#### CERTIFICATION
