## HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FISCAL YEAR 2009 CONTRACT RESOLUTION 1-21-09 C

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") grants the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2(i) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation is eligible and qualified to apply for contracts and grants with the Indian Health Service to plan, conduct and administer contract and grants; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Department of Health is virtually concerned about heart disease, immunizations, diabetes, other chronic diseases and all other health concerns; and
- WHEREAS,** sufficient funding is required to meet the health care delivery needs of all eligible individuals; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation shall comply with the Privacy Act of 1974 until such time a tribal policy is developed, the tribal policy shall then supersede; and
- WHEREAS,** the Division of Health Administrator is designated as the Tribal Senior Official for notices and proposed amendments to the contract, and other administrative issues relating to the contract; and
- WHEREAS,** within ninety (90) days after the end of the Fiscal Year, an Annual Report to the Indian People will be published to provide information on the programs, function, services, activities, and financial information pertaining to the contract.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature fully supports the Fiscal Year 2009 Ho-Chunk Nation's Health Department's proposal to maintain and elevate the health and well being of tribal members.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that said resolution shall be effective the date of adoption.
