HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE TRIBAL ROADS ARRA INVENTORY LIST RESOLUTION 8-18-09 C

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe, and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes, and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2, (i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreement with other governments, organizations, or individual; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation recognizes adequate and safe road infrastructure is critical to all Tribal development; and
- WEHREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs shares responsibility for developing and maintaining roads on Indian lands; and
- WEHREAS,** the Ho-Chunk wishes to update its road inventory to address the critical need for expanded and improved road infrastructure for a rapidly developing Tribal community.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Legislature, hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to add/update the roads listed in Attachment A to the Ho-Chunk Nation Indian Reservation Road Inventory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following names of roads and the assignment of the BIA route numbering system are attached to this resolution as Attachment A and are to be included in the Tribal Roads ARRA Inventory List.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Nation hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to update or add the list of roads in the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road Inventory.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Tribal Secretary for the Ho-Chunk Nation, hereby certify that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation, composed of the 13 members, of whom 12 constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting duly called and convened and held on the 18th day of August, 2009, that the foregoing resolution was adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 12 members, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining, pursuant to the authority of Article V, Section 2 (a) and (x) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 1, 1994, and that the foregoing resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
