

FORESTRY STARTUP GRANT FOR A HAZARD TREE/ URBAN
ASH INVENTORY & PUBLIC OUTREACH FOR TWO
HO-CHUNK NATION HOUSING COMMUNITIES
RESOLUTION 10-06-09 G**

- WHEREAS,** on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS,** the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Legislature") is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Nation ("Constitution"); and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") empowers Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature"), to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (i) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to negotiate agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 2 (l) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to enact laws to manage, lease, permit, or otherwise deal with the Nation's lands, interests in lands or other assets; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation Division of Natural Resources is responsible for managing air, land, and water resources; monitoring and controlling toxins, wastes, and pollutants; and protecting wildlife, fish, and plant resources from overuse and abuse; and
- WHEREAS,** the Ho-Chunk Nation recognizes the need to have a hazard tree/ urban ash inventory and public outreach of two Ho-Chunk housing communities for the safety of the residents, health of the trees and protection of personal property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature hereby approves this 2010 Urban Forestry Grant Application for a Hazard/ Urban Ash Inventory & Public Outreach for two Ho-Chunk Nation Housing Communities.

CERTIFICATION
