Who can help if you have not received your tax package?

How can you pay your back taxes?


Have the taxes prepared as usual. Advise your preparer that there will be penalty and interest due. All tax forms are ultimately sent to Tonya at Old Kent/ Fifth Third Bank. More information on preparing your taxes is in the Dec. '00 *Bulletin*.

Do you need to pay tax penalties?

If the IRS has sent you a statement that your minor owes penalty and interest, you need to pay it. Further penalties will accrue on unpaid taxes.

As of April, 2001, Old Kent Bank will have merged with Fifth Third Bank, another Great Lakes regional institution. The merger will enable us to serve you better. There will be no changes to your Trust, nor will there be a change in those professionals who manage it.




THE HO-CHUNK TRUST BULLETIN

How *has the Trust performed?*

The Ho-Chunk Nation Minor's Trust Fund is invested in 100% fixed income securities, commonly known as bonds. All the holdings are of the highest quality. The portfolio averages a AAA quality. The value of bonds may fluctuate in accordance with Federally-regulated interest rates. During the last twelve months, this sector of the economy has done very well.
