IN THE HO-CHUNK NATION SUPREME COURT

In Re Adoption of Revised Rule 13(a)(8) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Rules of Appellate

Procedure

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation;

WHEREAS, the CONSTITUTION OF THE HO-CHUNK NATION, ARTICLE VII, § 4, provides that the judicial power of the Ho-Chunk Nation shall be vested in the Judiciary; and,

WHEREAS, the CONSTITUTION OF THE HO-CHUNK NATION, ARTICLE VII, § 7(b), designates the Supreme Court of the Ho-Chunk Nation to establish written rules for the Judiciary, including procedural rules; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Ho-Chunk Nation Supreme Court hereby adopts revised rule 13(a)(8) of the *Ho-Chunk Rules of Appellate Procedure* to correct a clerical error in the rule. The rule shall change "Response Brief" to "Reply Brief" and state "All briefs shall not exceed (20) pages in length, excluding addenda, and *Reply Briefs* shall not exceed six (6) pages in length, excluding addenda." This revised rule is effective this 16th date of October 2017, from within the sovereign land of the
