FACILITY USAGE POLICY

Tribal and non-tribal community members will be allowed to reserve and use the facility for family, community and tribal activities with the following provisions;

- Administrative personnel will be present to open the building during pre-approved times of the activity and for the entirety of said activity
- Applicant will be responsible for the care of the facility during and after the activity
- Applicant must be present during the entirety of said activity
- At no time will drugs and/or alcohol be allowed in the facility
- At no time will any person be allowed in the facility while they are under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol
- At no time will animals be allowed in the facility – the only exception to this policy is if the animal is a licensed service animal, Legal documents must be presented to Administrative personnel
- Applicant will be responsible for any and all damages that occur during the activity
