



HO-CHUNK NATION

OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT

Administrative Order Mar. 13, 2020-1

WHEREAS, the General Council delegated authority to the executive branch to enforce the laws and administer funds pursuant to the CONSTITUTION OF THE HO-CHUNK NATION (CONSTITUTION), Art. IV, § 2; and

WHEREAS, the General Council delegates executive authority to the President of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the CONSTITUTION, Art. VI, § 1(a); and

WHEREAS, the CONSTITUTION indicates that the President shall of the power to execute and administer the laws of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the CONSTITUTION, Art. VI, § 2(a); and

WHEREAS, the President holds the power to administer all Departments, boards, and committees created by the Legislature pursuant to the CONSTITUTION, Art VI, § 2(d); and

WHEREAS, the President routinely enters administrative or executive orders pertaining to the administration of the executive branch.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the President, by the authority vested by the CONSTITUTION and the laws of the Ho-Chunk Nation, enters the follow administrative order effective upon the date of signature:

1. Declare a state of emergency for the Ho-Chunk Nation in response to the Coronavirus COVID- 19 pandemic, in accordance with Legislative resolution 03.12.2020A
2. Effective immediately all employment-related travel outside the State of Wisconsin, including previously scheduled travel will be suspended. Critical-needs travel will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Executive Directors may submit critical-travel requests to the Office of the President for approval. In addition employees should limit travel between work sites as much as possible.
3. All Executive Branch departments will assist in the Nation's ongoing response to this public health emergency.
4. Departments are directed to explore implementing communication technology and other operational solutions that will limit social interaction. Departments are required to submit plans to implement such measures, including costs, to Office of the President for approval as soon as possible.
5. All meetings of public boards and committees administered by the President will be suspended. Chairs may submit requests to hold critical meetings to the Office of the President for approval. Requests for virtual or telephonic meetings will also be considered.
6. Executive Directors will familiarize themselves with, and implement other requirements of resolution 03.12.2020A.
