## Petition:

A petition is an initial pleading that starts an action and states the basis for the court's jurisdiction, the basis for the petitioner's claim, and the demand for relief.

The petitioner is the party who brings the action to court i.e. the person who fills out the petition.

The respondent is the party being sued in the action - the person who currently has full custody of the minor child(ren) and/or shared custody of the minor child(ren) with you.

## Instructions:

- **Page 1, Lines 1-9:** Enter your full, legal name on the petitioner line. There can be more than one petitioner. Enter the respondent's full, legal name on the respondent line. There can be more than one respondent. You do not need to write a case number. A case number will be assigned by the Court.
- Page 1, Lines 12-28: Enter the applicable information as it relates to the petitioner.
- Page 2, Lines 1-16: Enter the applicable information as it relates to the respondent.
- Page 2, Lines 17-28 & Page 3: Lines 1-6: Enter the applicable information as it relates to the minor child(ren).
- Page 3, Lines 7-15: Jurisdiction is the court's power to exercise authority over all persons and things within its territory and to hear and decide a case or issue in dispute. The petitioner must show that the Ho-Chunk Nation Trial Court has jurisdiction over the action and the parties in the action.
