This option will expose you to cultural traditions, ceremonies, art, kinship, societal structure and social mores of the Ho-Chunk people. This course will allow you to learn more about Ho-Chunk traditions and help participants create a positive self-image. <i>Hybrid- online and in-person</i> .
	hunk Language: Bringing Hoocąk Home is an online family-oriented language program. This new language course is designed by the Ho-Chunk Language division. In this language learning experience, Wąąkšik Ho'į Pįį Hirušją Kįį participants and their families will work towards earning points while learning and using Hoocąk in the home.
