Dear Ho-Chunk Student,

The Higher Education Division is dedicated to supporting you in achieving your educational and professional goals. To be eligible for the Ho-Chunk Scholarship, you must fulfill the following requirements:

- Be an enrolled member of the Ho-Chunk Nation by the start of the academic term;
- Be interested/accepted/enrolled into a progressive degree program at a Title IV regionally accredited non-profit institution that is financial aid eligible (subject to approval);
- Properly file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually;
- Complete the Ho-Chunk Scholarship process in its entirety.

We advise submitting your application **90 days** prior to the start of your term and maintaining regular communication with our office. Supporting documents can be submitted as the documents become available. Students that submit an application by the following timelines will be given priority in processing:

Fall 2025 – July 15 for the academic year and Winter/Spring 2026 – October 15 if you start mid-year.

\*Students have one opportunity, per degree level, to qualify for a scholarship after the deadline with a letter explaining the late submission.

Required documents to complete the scholarship process:	Timeline:				
1. 2025-2026 Ho-Chunk Scholarship Application (HSA) – One complete application is required each academic year, and is valid fall 2025, winter and spring 2026	Priority filing date for annual application: Fall term - June 15, 2025 Mid-year start: Winter/Spring - October 15, 2026				
The Ho-Chunk Scholarship Application is recommend to be sent 90 days prior to the start of coursework. The supporting documents listed below (items 2-8) can be completed/submitted as they become available.					
2. Complete a 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) - file/renew annually	https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa				
3. Acceptance/Admission Letter (new, transfer, and reentering students) including your name, school and program name	Submit once officially accepted – required once per degree program				
<ol> <li>Class Schedule - including your name, school name, term, class name, and number of credits</li> </ol>	Submit once you are registered for the term				
<ol> <li>Itemized Billing Statement - including your name, school name, term, and breakdown of expenses/charges</li> </ol>	Submit once your expenses/charges are posted to your student account				
<ol> <li>Financial Aid Award Summary/Offer - including grants, scholarships, work-study, and/or loan offers</li> </ol>	Submit once your financial aid is awarded by the school's Financial Aid Office				
<ol> <li>Official Transcript - only if <u>previously funded</u>, must be sent directly from school's clearinghouse to Highered</li> </ol>	Submit once final grades are posted to close out previously funded term				
8. Certificate Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB) - from the Ho-Chunk Nation Enrollment Department	As soon as possible – required once, except for changes in legal name				





Student Rights and Responsibilities:

- I understand the Ho-Chunk Scholarship will not be processed until I submit <u>all</u> required documents. I acknowledge that the funding process may take several weeks and that applying early is in my best interest.
- I acknowledge financial responsibility for my school fees and charges until the award is processed and sent to the school.
- I agree that participation in this program is voluntary. Upon using an award, I must meet the scholarship's minimum requirements. Violations may result in probation, suspension, and/or financial responsibility.
- I understand that the Ho-Chunk Nation is not responsible for any impact our scholarship program may have on other funding, including Welfare, Social Security, SSI, Medicare, or grants, scholarships, and fellowships from any source.
- I hereby acknowledge that I have read and fully understand the rules, terms, and conditions of the Higher Education Division Operating Policy and agree to abide by said rules, terms, and conditions of the policy and scholarship award letter.

Scholarship awards are based on information from the needs analysis prepared by the school's financial aid office as determined by FAFSA results, the school's budget, enrollment status, valid billing statement, and remaining terms of eligibility. Funding is based on a standard semester system. Coursework completed part-time, online, or quarter-based will be converted to an equivalent semester ratio.

\*Full-time students accepted into a four-year program, and determined by the school's Financial Aid Office as need-based, may require some original documents due to Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) grant as the funding source.
