(30 minutes)

This workshop is geared towards parents and school districts. The use of the Johnson O'Malley program aligns fairly close with the Title 6 grant that school districts can apply for.

## Ho-Chunk 101

(45 minutes)

## Ho-Chunk Resilience

(45 Minutes)

This workshop is focused on Ho-Chunk resilience through the Indian Removal Acts, Boarding Schools and Historical Trauma. We will review the resilience the Ho-Chunk people have had to overcome and how it has genetically changed DNA. We will touch on Historical trauma and learn ways to best educate and move forward to create better brain health. *\*This workshop is geared towards parents and educators who are struggling with Native American student behaviors or high ACE's scores.*

## Act 31 in your classroom

(45 minutes)

This workshop reiterates the importance of Act 31 in your classrooms. We will review the legalities of Act 31. Teachers will be given the resources and direct tools they can use to incorporate or enhance lessons into your classrooms.

*\*This workshop is geared toward educators who are eager to enhance student learning with regards to Native American histories.*

## Cultural Infusion with Curriculum

(30 minutes)

This workshop will provide an openness to exploring your current curriculum and how it reflects your students directly. We will discuss creating conversational communities that drive change. We will give an introduction to the *Seeking Educational Equity & Diversity* (SEED) trainings and upcoming training dates.
